Parents' Code of Conduct, Behaviour and Responsibilities

All parents/guardians who attend any game where a player from St George Junior Baseball Club, Inc. is participating are obliged to sign the following Code of Conduct. It requires that you meet the high conduct standards expected from a supporter as a role model and as an individual.

Please read carefully before you sign.

As a parent/guardian or spectator of a St George Junior Baseball Club, Inc. player or game, I will:

- Ensure my child is punctual for games and training sessions. (All players who excelled at this sport carried out full training in their younger years). Remember warm-up commences one hour before the scheduled start of any game.
- Notify the team coach/es or team manager early if attendance at training or games is not possible.
- Attend games whenever possible and show interest and support for your child and the team's success.
- Assist in the canteen, BBQ and ground set up and pack up duties when requested.
- Look for opportunities to assist your child's team and/or the Club:
 - \circ $\;$ Learn to umpire for the team
 - o Learn to score for the team
 - Operate the BBQ
 - o Staff the canteen
 - Use your professional skills from work to help the Club, e.g. landscapers helping with field maintenance, etc.
 - Help set up the diamond before the game and help pack away after the game.
- Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage children to participate; do not force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good plays by all teams.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show respect and appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Abide by NSW Health orders and check in with QR codes when available.
